*My ukulele arrangement of the beautiful tune, from the 1940 Disney animation Pinocchio, that has deservedly become a standard. The little-known introductory verse is included here, sadly omitted from most recorded versions of the song I've heard.*

*The piece should be played at slow-medium tempo but not in strict time. Play expressively, allowing the tempo to ebb and flow as you see fit.*

**Please note:** if your uke only has 12 frets, the last chord can have its highest note at fret 10 or simply be a basic G chord.
